## EXCITING PROGRAMS PLANNED

For 2012, we have put together an exciting calendar of events. Handlers, puppies, and dogs will take over the clubhouse on June 24 for "Obedience School". To expand our circle of friends even more, we will have four bar nights this year: March 9 at Touché, May 24 at The Hole, July 13 at The Hole, and August 10 at Touché. ## **NOTICE TO ALL CLUBHOUSE ATTENDEES**

In order for the Chicago Hellfire Club to continue to be successful and full of hot sex and play during all of our events, it's important to remember some items so that problems won't interrupt our fun:

- To help us maintain a good relationship with our neighbors, please dress appropriately when you and your guests arrive and depart:
- No extreme leather or fetish wear or toys are to be worn or displayed outside the club: No bare asses or chests, hoods, masks, leashes, or boys on their knees. Keep your toys and tools out of sight until you are inside the clubhouse.
- Arrive and depart quietly.
- All attendees are required to show their valid, government-issued ID. When you arrive, we like to get everyone inside as quickly as possible so we don't have a line on the street. Having your ID out when you get to the check-in window just inside the door will keep the line moving quickly.
- Photography in the clubhouse is forbidden at all times, except by club-selected official photographer(s).
- Drug use will not be tolerated.
- We take our members' and guests' safety seriously. DMs are on duty to ensure someone is watching, but it is the responsibility of all members to enforce the club's safer sex policies, listed in our Standing Legislation, Attachment 19. Prohibitions include, but are not limited to: unprotected anal intercourse; fisting without rubber gloves; needles, pins, catheters, sounds, or other devices intended to break the skin or invade a body orifice used on more than one individual without sterilization between uses; sharing of sex toys which come in contact with any bodily secretions

## PRESERVING OUR PAST

This Spring issue of the Brand starts the beginning of a new year for the Chicago Hellfire Club newsletter which is distributed to our guests and members. While we all look forward to the future and the fun to be experienced with our brothers and friends, please consider the importance of preserving our history; how we have come to be and all that we have accomplished during our 40 years. The CHC-Fireside Archives Preservation Fund, in conjunction with the Leather Archives and Museum is meant to help with that effort.

### **CHC-Fireside Archives Preservation Fund**

CHC has an agreement with the Leather Archives and Museum (LA&M) to establish a restricted fund for the purpose of maintaining, preserving, and developing CHC's archived materials; this fund is called the CHC-Fireside Archives Preservation Fund. The fund is under the maintenance and control of LA&M, and as such, donations to this fund would benefit from the LA&M's 501(c)(3) charitable, non-profit tax status. Fund use is restricted to activities with CHC archive materials. To continue this effort, we ask you to consider making donations to the fund. ## McADORY HERE TO HELP

After CHC member Michael McAdory passed in 1984, a fund was created in his name to provide financial assistance to members of the leather community whose health left them short of funds to pay for housing, utilities, medical care, and other necessities. In the years since, leather men and women sponsored by our members have received over \$120,000 in aid from this fund. And today, that fund remains open and available to any member of the leather/fetish/kink community with an urgent financial need.

We provide a hand up, not a handout. We can only offer limited support - \$300/month, up to \$1200/year under normal circumstances to any person, and each request for aid must be sponsored by a CHC member. But that small amount of aid can mean the difference between insolvency and survival.
