WELCOME TO THE HOUSE

A few notes about coming and going

In order for the Chicago Hellfire Club to continue to be successful and full of hot sex and play during all of our events, it's important to remember some items so that problems won't interrupt our fun.

- To help maintain a good relationship with our neighbors, dress appropriately when you and your guests arrive and depart. This means:
- 1. No extreme leather or fetish wear or toys are to be worn or displayed outside the club No bare asses or chests, hoods, masks, leashes, or boys on their knees. Keep your toys and tools out of sight until you are inside the clubhouse.
 - 2. Arrive and depart quietly.
- All attendees are required to show their valid, government-issued ID. When you arrive, we like to get everyone inside as quickly as possible so we don't have a line on the street. Having your ID out when you get to the check-in window just inside the door will keep the line moving quickly.
- Photography in the clubhouse is forbidden at all times, except by club-selected official photographer(s).
- Drug use will not be tolerated.
- We take our members' and guests' safety seriously. DMs are on duty to ensure someone is watching, but it is the responsibility of all members to enforce the club's safer sex policies, listed in our Standing Legislation, Attachment 19. Prohibitions include, but are not limited to: unprotected anal intercourse; fisting without rubber gloves; needles, pins, catheters, sounds, or other devices intended to break the skin or invade a body orifice used on more than one individual without sterilization between uses; sharing of sex toys which come in contact with any bodily secretions.

Want to Get in the Middle?



Inferno, CHC's annual premier event — held in September and attended by invitation / sponsored by members in good standing. Men wishing to join CHC must have three member sponsors — one of whom must be a full member of the Club and one must have been a play partner.

Connecting with CHC members might sound difficult for those living outside our home base of Chicago, but our brothers live in many places around the world and can often be found at various leather events and other venues wearing their club colors. If you want to make a connection, introduce yourself and ask if you can talk about the Club. Building relationships is essential to seeking membership.

Your sponsors will help you through the other parts of the application process as well as explaining the minimum requirements which include attending at least one Inferno and visiting our clubhouse at least once in the twelve months prior to your application.

Even if you're not considering membership right now, but simply want to build relationships with men who like to play the way you do, or you're looking for someone to sponsor you to attend a Club party or Inferno, take the first step. ARCHIVES

Preservation Fund

CHC has with the Leather Archives and Museum (LA&M) established a restricted fund for the purpose of maintaining, preserving, and developing CHC's archived materials. This fund is called the CHC-Fireside Archives Preservation Fund. The fund is under the maintenance and control of LA&M, and as such, donations to this fund would benefit from the LA&M's 501(c)(3) charitable, non-profit tax status. Fund use is restricted to activities with CHC archive materials.

After CHC member Michael McAdory passed in 1984, a fund was created in his name to provide financial assistance to members of the leather community whose health left them short of funds to pay for housing, utilities, medical care, and other necessities.

In the years since, leather men and women sponsored by our members have received over \$120,000 in aid from this fund. And today, that fund remains open and available to any member of the leather/fetish/kink community with an urgent financial need.

We provide a hand up, not a handout. We can only offer limited support — \$300/month, up to \$1200/year under normal circumstances to any person, and each request for aid must be sponsored by a CHC member. But that small amount of aid can mean the difference between insolvency and survival.
