

This year the men of the House subcommittee have been working hard to maintain and improve our play space.

While most of us were at Inferno, a few members stripped, waxed, and buffed the floor in the main dungeon. This will make the floor easier to keep clean and maintain. Also, a number of floor tiles were repaired or replaced this year.

After Inferno, we made some changes to the dungeon layout.

The bondage bed that was previously in the back room has now been moved into the main dungeon. This was done to allow members to more fully utilize the capabilities of this great piece of equipment.

You will also notice a new bootblack stand made by Associate member, Travis F., in the basement social area.

Metal holders have been installed for holding paper towels and bottles of cleaning products. This frees up space on the small black tables so that members now have more space for storing their equipment during a scene.

The two Saint Andrews crosses and one bondage table have been re-varnished. This improves their appearance and will help protect them from rain and moisture when they travel to Inferno in the future.

On top of this, we have been doing a lot of work on general house maintenance and repair, shopping for supplies, cleaning the clubhouse, touching up paint, fixing issues with the doorbell and entry system, and cleaning up after the floor flooded this spring.

I would like to thank the men who serve on the House subcommittee and anyone who has volunteered their time and talents this year. The house is an incredible asset for the club, and we appreciate those members dedicated to maintaining it and making it even better.

I initially went into Inferno thinking of it only as a fetish/kink weekend. Sex, bondage and fun. Great, but while it contains all of these things, I discovered that those items are not the defining traits or even a fraction of what Inferno is.

From setup I discovered that the individual is part of an overall team, and this team quickly developed into a community of friends. "We are not finished until we are all finished" was repeated more than once. It rang true as the means to accomplish all that needed to be done in a short amount of time. It was hard work, and I questioned to myself if the end result would be worth the effort.

It most definitely was.

Every man I met was approachable, helpful, and friendly. I can honestly say I didn't meet one person who was rude, stand-offish or unapproachable to a new person. All were more than willing to help or assist in any manner and answered all my questions or directed me to someone who could.

An initial bond was formed during setup which easily lasted throughout session A. I can honestly say without working setup I would have entered the event much more shy, reserved, and quiet. I am positive that without working setup I would not have enjoyed myself as much as I did nor have felt comfortable enough to truly be myself. When session A started I was already acquainted with many individuals and had begun to develop bonds of interest and trust.

I was fortunate to have my mentor there to guide me to be

cautious, not because men were untrustworthy, but because I was not prepared for the intense play they are into normally. I was told to slow down, and take it at the right pace. And everyone was fine with that. I was very fortunate to meet men in some leather families, and they were everything a family should be in every way. That was very affirming, and in many ways they were the foundation from which I explored Inferno.

When the day to leave at the end of Session A came, I truly regretted leaving. I wished with all my heart I could stay longer and remain in the company of the people there.

When I got home and tried to describe it to my husband I found that words really do not do justice to describing Inferno and my experience. It was much like describing a rainbow to a person who is blind. I was easily able to describe the grounds and people we both knew. But it was special. These men care for you, they care for each other, and they share with you the play and events. But the community that is there, the feelings you get, the bonds you develop -- those turned out to be almost impossible to describe. The only description I can give would be a community, a family, and a group of men who allow you to be yourself and won't judge you one way or the other for who you are and what you enjoy, no matter what your level of experience.

It's more than play, much, much more. These men care for you and they support you in ways that nobody else can. That is Inferno. That is best description I can give.

Happy to be there and I will be back

The McAdory Fund Helps Leather Folk



"Since its inception the [McAdory] fund has provided over \$190,000 in grants."

The Chicago Hellfire Club is proud to provide help to those in the leather community who are having financial difficulties. The primary purpose of the McAdory Fund is to provide immediate direct financial aid on a temporary basis to any members of the leather/SM/fetish community who demonstrates financial need they cannot meet on their own. The McAdory Fund was created almost 30 years ago by the Chicago Hellfire Club in the memory of Michael McAdory, to provide financial support to members of the leather community whose health left them unable to pay rent, medical bills, and other necessities. Since its inception the fund has provided over \$190,000 in grants.

As part of the McAdory committee I have been able to see with my own eyes leather men and women who were able to use their grants as a springboard to get past a major hurdle in their lives. I have seen this fund make a real difference.

If you or someone you know is in need of assistance we ask that you follow these steps:

- Are you a CHC member in good standing? If not, please be sure a referral email is sent to the committee by a CHC member in good standing. That email should be sent to mcadory@hellfire13.net. If you do not have a sponsor please notify the committee, and an attempt will be made to connect you with a potential sponsor.
- 2. Request a grant application at: mcadory@hellfire13.net.

House Rules

In order for the Chicago Hellfire Club to continue to be successful and full of hot sex and play during all of our events, it's important to remember some items so that problems won't interrupt our fun.

- To help maintain a good relationship with our neighbors, dress appropriately when you and your guests arrive and depart. This means:
- 1. No extreme leather, fetish wear or toys are to be worn or displayed outside the club. No bare asses or chests, hoods, masks, leashes, or boys on their knees. Keep your toys and tools out of sight until you are inside the clubhouse.
- 2. Arrive and depart quietly.
- All attendees are required to show their valid, government-issued ID. When you arrive, we like to get everyone inside as quickly as possible so we don't have a line on the street. Having your ID out when you get to the check-in window just inside the door will keep the line moving quickly.
- Photography is strictly prohibited in the clubhouse except by club designated photographers – Don't risk getting caught! Just don't take pictures of that hot scene you were watching or involved in. Keep everyone safe.
- Drug use will not be tolerated.
- We take our members' and guests' safety seriously. DMs are on duty to ensure someone is watching, but it is the responsibility of all members to enforce the club's safer sex policies, listed in our Standing Legislation, Attachment 19. Prohibitions include, but are not limited to: unprotected anal intercourse; fisting without rubber gloves; needles, pins, catheters, sounds, or other devices intended to break the skin or invade a body orifice used on more than one individual without sterilization between uses; sharing of sex toys which come in contact with any bodily secretions.

Clean up after yourself.

Before leaving the clubhouse, keep these things in mind:

GARBAGE Have you picked up trash, emptied all the garbage cans, relined them and taken the trash to the alley? ELECTRIC Have you turned off all electric appliances—coffee pot, fans, smoke eater, etc.?

THERMOSTAT Have you turned off all air conditioners?

LIGHTS Have you turned off all the lights, including the bathrooms and back halls?

AMPLIFIERS Are you sure you've turned off all amplifiers (CD player, radios, tape players, TV, etc.)?

INSIDE DOORS Have you locked the office door and checked all back doors?

DOOR Will you be sure to check the front door and make sure it is locked securely after you have gone out?
