My First Inferno

I've read about Inferno for years, and even have copies of the Inferno XV "Official Program" publication and the Drummer / Zeus Inferno XV photo book in my collection. But I ended up at Inferno 44 almost by accident after mentioning off-handedly to my eventual CHC sponsor and long-time friend that I wouldn't be able to make it to Delta. When he replied "What about Inferno?", I was nearly speechless. Was fantasy about to become reality?

He said that even though it was late, there would probably be vacancies for Session B. I said I would have to run it by Daddy. A few days later, a good opportunity came up to broach the subject, and Daddy was open to the idea but insisted on a family discussion including our boy. By the end of our talk, I had my family's support.

Packing was an interesting experience – what to take? The weather, fortunately, looked to be good. I'm generally a switch and was looking forward to some serious impact play but didn't want to take too much gear that might not be used, so I packed a few favorites along with a variety of leatherwear that I thought would get me through.

Once I made a very tight connection en route to my destination airport, my thoughts turned to what was in store. Who would be there? How would I, a newbie, be viewed? How do people connect? What if my dance card ends up empty?

Not seeing anyone at the airport, I called my sponsor and got instructions on where to wait. A few others began to gather, and we chatted about our respective backgrounds and experiences, a conversation that continued in the van on the way to the venue. After checking in, I headed to my accommodation, dropped my luggage, and met back up with my sponsor for a quick tour before my duty briefing, followed immediately by the newbie orientation and, soon afterwards, dinner.

My first impressions were that there was a wide variety of ages, shapes, and sizes and that many had been attending Inferno for years, making it something of a challenge for an introverted newbie like me to make connections. I spent a lot of time walking around that Sunday evening and almost turned in but decided to go for the midnight snack, which turned out to be quite crowded. I ended up connecting for an hour-long session with a late-arriving newbie who was disappointed that no one seemed interested in playing, followed by a shorter but intense session with the DM after the space had cleared out.

Monday afternoon consisted of two good sessions – one bottoming, one topping – but Monday night left me initially feeling isolated. Not connecting with anyone, I eventually decided to just enjoy watching. I ended the night sitting around the fire with my sponsor and other regulars as they reminisced about Inferno history and realized that the nature of Inferno isn't just the orgasmic fantasy I had imagined but also a retreat where friends get to spend quality time together – the play, while important, was also spaced with ample social opportunities.

Lots of people spent lots of time socializing – at all hours! There was an incredible sense of community, or even family. Again, as an introverted newbie, it wasn't easy to get into established circles, but it was a thrill nonetheless to watch it unfolding, to feel that incredible positive energy around me, and I was eventually able to feel more a part of that energy, both as a result of some great scenes and from contributing through my duty shift and some unplanned work at teardown. Whispers of admiration as I left the Music Room after a long and intense session with a weeping badge of honor on my back convinced me that quality was more important than quantity when it comes to Inferno.

The level of specialization and expertise that I witnessed was mind blowing, as was the level of organization that made the event both possible and incredibly successful. Even the trip back to airport and the wait for my flight turned out to be wonderful experiences as I enjoyed the extra time with new friends.

Will I return? I'd love to, and I know that I'd feel welcome. Maybe I'd even be able to try Session A if I ever know my schedule far enough in advance. But the great memories of 44 will be with me forever.

Experience the CHC Parties during IML Weekend

Although there are many opportunities to play and socialize with CHC throughout the year, there are four times each year when the Club is host to large numbers of men and exciting play. One is the Club's signature summer camp, Inferno; another is the Associate/Applicant Weekend in November, a third is the Triple Play Weekend in July and the fourth is during the IML Weekend. Well, IML Weekend is coming up and the Club is preparing to welcome members and guests for their very special IML Weekend play parties at the CHC Clubhouse.

If you are planning to be in Chicago for IML and would like to attend one or more of the three CHC play parties during that weekend, fill out the form included in this issue and send it to the Club to reserve your tickets. Tickets are required for the party due to practical limits on Clubhouse space. In order to attend one of the parties, you must arrive with your ticket and a government issued picture ID. If you are a guest of a member, you must complete the IML party form and then have your sponsor-member sign your form before it is returned to CHC. Tickets should be picked up at the CHC booth in the Leather Mart at the IML hotel during IML Weekend. You can also get directions to the Clubhouse or suggestions on how to get there at the CHC booth.

If this is your first trip to the CHC Clubhouse, what can you expect? Well, you will be asked to arrive at the Clubhouse in clothing that is NOT revealing or too kinky – the Clubhouse is located in a residential area and the Club likes to maintain good relationships with neighbors. For that same reason, you are asked not to arrive before the opening time to avoid having to stand outside the Clubhouse. If the door is not open when you arrive, ring the doorbell. Inside your ticket and ID will be checked and you will be asked to sign a release. With all of that process stuff behind you, you can change into whatever kinky gear you may have brought along and either grab a drink (water, soda, beer) and snacks in the social area or head off to one of the play areas.

It is not that many years ago when I arrived on my first trip to the Clubhouse during an IML Weekend. I was sponsored by an Associate member I had met about a year earlier. The summer before, as we had been playing, he began to tell me about the Club, but as happens, the significance of what he was saying went right over my head. Later that summer, I began to read some old articles about Inferno and what went on there and finally the light bulb went off in my head that this was the same Club my eventual sponsor had been telling me about. I asked him if he would sponsor me for Inferno, but because it was so late in the summer and, probably more importantly because I had never been to any event at that point, he told me that he would sponsor me for the following year if I went to several leather events.

He suggested MAL and so I set my sights on that event and attended. It was eye-opening to say the least and so much fun that I immediately signed up for CLAW and then IML. My sponsor was also attending IML and made sure I got to the Clubhouse for the Friday night party, and I went again for the Saturday party and the Sunday party. I had some great play sessions that first trip to CHC, but more importantly I also had volunteered to help by putting out snacks, keeping the refrigerator stocked with drinks and cleaning up the social area. It was a great way to meet other members of the Club and other guests too. It was my start in the Club and my sponsor had put me on a great path.

While you may look at going to the Clubhouse during IML Weekend as simply an opportunity to experience a great play space (and it is), it is also a great place to initiate long-lasting friendships that may, hopefully, lead you to joining us by becoming a member of the Chicago Hellfire Club. We hope you can make it to the CHC IML Weekend parties – we know you will have a great time at the Clubhouse.

CLAW 16: April 28-May 1, Cleveland

Two Host Hotels: Huge Vendor Mart and Men's BDSM Play Space

More than 80 Skills and Education Sessions on schedule so far!

CLAW 16 has two host hotels --The Holiday Inn Cleveland South, host of CLAW 15, and a phenome-

nal Embassy Suites, very nearby. Both are sold out, and an entire third hotel is going fast. Book now at the Comfort Inn: 216-328-7777. All the hotels are within easy walking distance, and free shuttle vans will be available around the clock. More than 2000 leather men are expected at CLAW 16.

Our biggest ever vendor mart will be all in one room -- the magnificent Embassy Suite Grand Ballroom. That allows for an expanded Men's BDSM Play Space -- with 50% longer hours than last year. It also makes room for a big expansion in the Skills and Education sessions, more than twice as many as last year, including several taught by CHC brothers. Highlights include "City of Wounded Boys and Sexual Warriors", a career retrospective slideshow and discussion with legendary San Francisco photographer Mark Chester; "The Dynamics of Male Chastity", presented by Spanner Trust head Derek Cohen and slave David Williams, from London; and "Human Pup Play: Where to from Here?", presented by Dr. George Forgan-Smith, from Melbourne, Australia. Skills sessions include sessions on flogging, cbt, wax, fisting, electro torture, several bondage topics, sounding, biting, paddling, rubber, and much more. Most of the skills sessions at CLAW are participatory. Community discussions include a Sir/boy roundtable, pup community networking, leather history, scat play, and more. New this year: Bootblack Apprenticeships, from one of CLAW's more than 20 volunteer bootblacks. A complete schedule of CLAW 16 Skills and Education is available on the CLAW website.

Friday night's highlight is "Strip Bingo!" with hot male strippers and special performances, vendor sponsored games and prizes, and "Golden Cock Games" where you can win a limited edition magnificent golden dildo, provided by Square Peg Toys. Love Goddess comedian Judy Tenuta will perform a very special CLAW set on Saturday night at 11:00 pm in the Impulse Lounge at the Holiday Inn. \$20 separate ticket required. On Sunday night "Broadway Bound", a cabaret show of singers and comics, hosted by CLAW's hilarious emcees Larry Golubski and Lulu Belle.

The "Bears and Balls Pool Party" is Saturday night at the Holiday Inn, and "Dog Paddle pup Pool Party" is Friday night, both at the Holiday Inn. Speaking of pups, there is a huge pup mosh pit party and several pup related education events.
