Our next Demo and dungeon party is on **Saturday night, October 14**, from 8pm to 2am. The doors will be open from 7:45pm to 11pm. The party is non-smoking and is open to registered members and guests. Demo attendees should plan to arrive at 7:45pm to complete check-in.

Demo

The demo begins at 8pm, and the title is "Hey guy, would you like come and see my new equipment?" Over the past few months, the Program Committee has searched the internet for new dungeon equipment and now decisions have been made. On Saturday night, October 14, various presenters will show you the new equipment in the clubhouse dungeon, and instruct you in how to safely use it. This is a demo you don't want to miss! Watch for Your AA Weekend Invite

Your Eventbrite invite for Associates and Applicants Weekend will be sent out in mid October. The invite will include member and guest tickets for the banquet and the parties. Members and guests will be able to pay online via credit card, pay cash at the door, and pay by check in advance or at the door.

Applicants may receive an Eventbrite Guest invite, but they are instructed that their party and banquet tickets are already paid for by their application fee, and they should not buy any tickets for any of the AA Weekend events. Membership will provide Program with the names of applicants who will be attending the parties and the banquet, and their names will be added directly to the party list.

The schedule for AA Weekend is as follows:

- Sunday, November 12 – AAW Brunch and Play Party at the Clubhouse, 11 am to 3 pm

The price for the banquet will be \$25 for members and guests, and the suggested donation for guests will be \$20 for each party, or \$50 for all three parties.

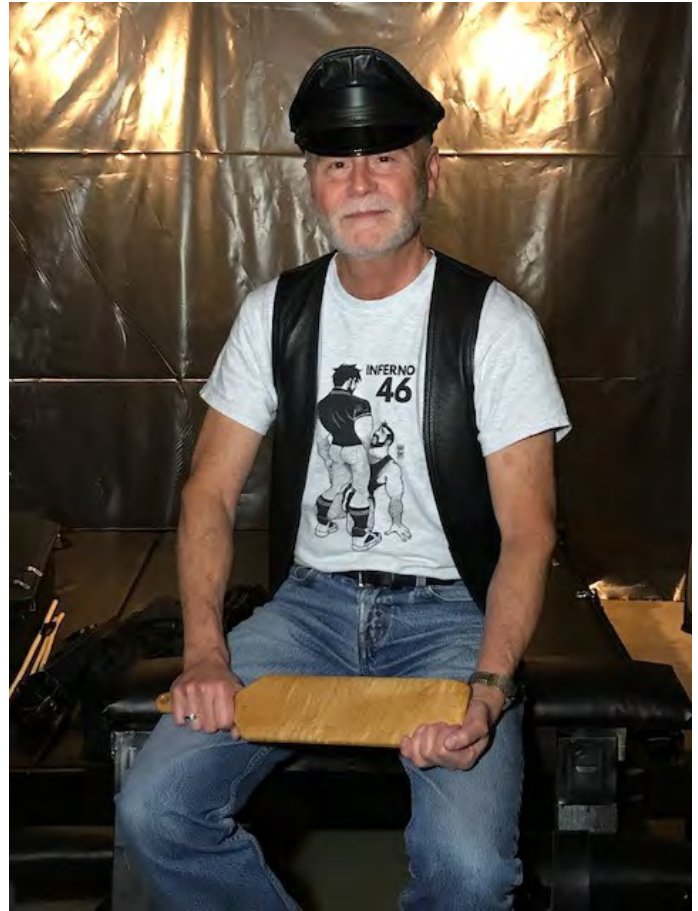
