CRACS was founded by CHC Full Member Guangshuo Y who was interested in forming a specialized club where inexperienced members could learn


proper techniques of whip cracking from experienced practitioners and then transition to S&M whipping.

The one hour demonstration will be introduced by CRACS members Jack M from CHC and Bob L from Leather & Fetish Milano (LFM). CRACS members Wade and Gabe will do the demo and will utilize safe whipping techniques including a proper warm up followed by the singletailing.

Saturday Night, May 12 Demo and Dungeon Party

On Saturday, May 12, bondage fantasies will inhabit the dungeon. The doors will be open from 7:45pm to 11 pm. The demo will begin at 8pm, and the party begins at 9 pm. All events are non-smoking and are open to registered members and guests.



Demo - 8pm

The demo will be presented by David W, a CHC Full Member. David is a longtime enthusiast of bondage and sensation play in various forms. He's currently the host/organizer of CRACS, the singletail whip club that meets monthly at the clubhouse. He is also actively involved in the Chicago rope community as a student at Second City Kinbaku. While his first time wrapping a boy in plastic wrap and duct tape was over 20 years ago, it is only recently that immobilization has become a regular part of his play repertoire, both as storage bondage for its own sake and in combination with impact, edging, hypnosis, tt/cbt, and other forms of sensation play.

Demo – Wrapped and Trapped – Immobilization, Mummification, and Storage Bondage

In this demo, David will show a number of different immobilization methods, some involving special gear items such as sleep-sacks. The main focus will be a start-to-finish full body mummification with plastic wrap and duct tape, including how to cut openings into the body wrap for things like tt/cbt, electro, or impact. He'll discuss ways to minimize risk, stay connected with your sub, and make the whole wrapping process fun and hot. The demo will also include brief interviews with a few cute boys describing the experience of getting wrapped and trapped and why they find it so incredibly sexy.

Party

After the demo, the dungeon party begins at 9 pm, and once the Dungeon Master is in the room you can feel free to start any scene you have planned. Maybe you'll be inspired to wrap someone up!

Getting the Most out of CHC Parties

If you're new to CHC or need a reminder on how our parties work, here are some simple suggestions to help make your evening enjoyable:

Dungeon Masters

Dungeon Masters are a very important part of CHC play parties. Our Dungeon Masters wear an orange vest and are in charge of all play in the room. Please give them your respect and remember that their decisions about play are final. And, if you're preparing to do a scene that might be seen as overly intense, it's always wise to let the DM know in advance.

Noise in the Dungeon

I frequently mention that audible talking needs to happen downstairs during a party. Imagine being bound to a table enjoying an erotic headspace then hearing someone near you discussing their shopping list, a project at work, or worse, critiquing the scene you're in. Also, if your sub is a

screamer, you will need to quiet him with a gag or change the scene to reduce the noise. We are, after all, located in a residential neighborhood.

Social Area

Our social area is downstairs, and this is where you can sit and enjoy a snack and a beverage, talk all you want with other players, and watch a video.

CHC Party Dynamics

Some members and guests attend our parties already having a scene in mind. Others attend without having anything planned, just to see what opportunities the evening presents. Don't be a wallflower! Increase your chances of future play by engaging members and guests in conversation in our social area downstairs. Introduce yourself and ask questions to get the conversation going. Remember, unlike online hookups, Hellfire Club is your opportunity to meet players face to face, watch them play, and get to know them before you approach them about a possible scene.

Consent

You'll also want to make sure that you and the person or persons with whom you play discuss the upcoming scene and what is being consented to. Make sure there is agreement between all parties as to how a change in consent will be handled.

How to Register

Registration for IML Weekend will be done exclusively via Eventbrite and the invite will include RSVPs and donation tickets for members and guests. A full list of volunteer choices will also be available in the invite as we need your support to fill all of our volunteer choices for the three parties.

Look for your IML Weekend Eventbrite invite the evening of April 23. Eventbrite registration will close on Thursday afternoon, May 24.

Once you've registered via Eventbrite, you will need to visit the CHC IML Booth, pay any balance due, fill out your Release Forms, and pick up your printed tickets. All members and guests must have a ticket and a government issued picture ID to be admitted to a party.

Already filled out a Release Form in 2018? We'll have a list of who has filled out a form in 2018, so if your name is on that list you can skip this step.

Can't make it to the IML Booth to pick up your tickets? If there is no balance due and our records show that you have already filled out a release form in 2018, you can email the Program Director at program@hellfire13.net and request alternate arrangements for ticket pickup.

Who can nominate?

Any club member in good standing.

Who is eligible?

Men who are members of the gay S&M community and are legitimately eligible to attend Inferno.

Members can email inferno@hellfire13.net with their nominations. You should include enough information that the Inferno Committee can make an equitable decision on the nomination. It is also helpful if you include a picture of the nominee.

Helping out at Inferno

Remember as you fill in your duty assignment requests on your application, these are important jobs that need bodies. Being selected to work Setup or Teardown counts as duty for one session of

Inferno. That frees your time during the run for play. If you work both Setup and Teardown, you have the run entirely to yourself. Think about the options.

We are especially looking for men with skills in woodworking and carpentry for Setup, I encourage all to consider requesting the duty assignment.

2. Arrive and depart quietly.


 All attendees are required to show their valid, government-issued ID.


Gentlemen,
