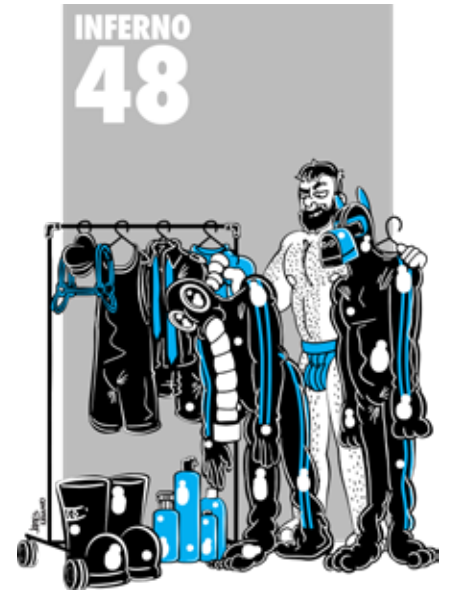
your sponsor and get on their list. Even if you aren't sure you can attend Inferno this year it is still better to get on your sponsors list and receive an application with the first round of guest applications.
